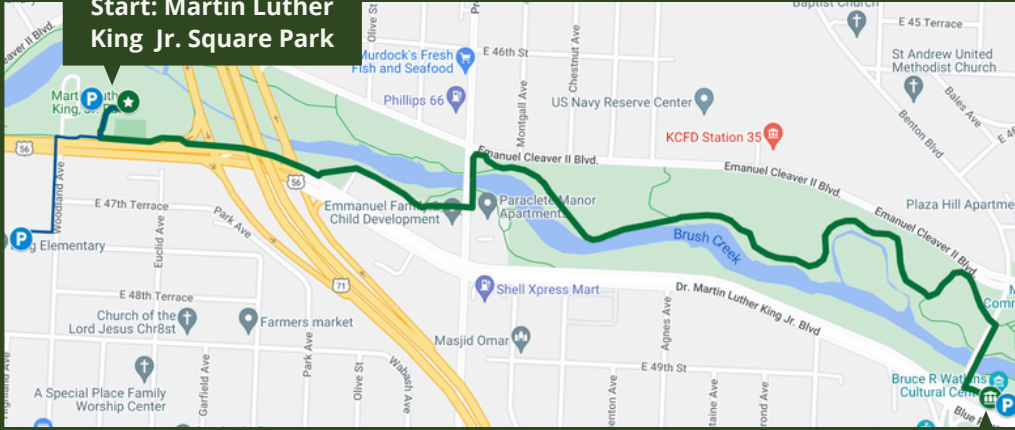

- You may join the guided nature walk along Brush Creek (a tributary of the Blue River), the post-walk gathering at the Cultural Center, or both.
- The guided 1.5 mile one-way nature walk led by USFWS will focus on environmental justice as we follow a mostly paved path from the MLK, Jr. Square Park to the Bruce R. Watkins Cultural Center.
- Leashed dogs are welcome on the walk, but are not allowed inside the Cultural Center.
- Event is rain or shine so please dress for the weather and wear comfortable walking shoes.
